



Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

En el ciclo de catequesis dedicadas al celo apostólico, hoy nos inspira el testimonio de santa Josefina Bakhita. Nació en Sudán y, cuando tenía apenas siete años, fue raptada y convertida en esclava. Durante su esclavitud padeció numerosos sufrimientos físicos y morales. A pesar de tantas heridas recibidas, cuando conoció a Cristo experimentó una gran liberación interior, se sintió comprendida, amada, y capaz de amar y perdonar, como Jesús perdonó a los que lo crucificaron.

La experiencia del perdón hizo de Bakhita una mujer pacífica y pacificadora, libre y liberadora. Su ejemplo nos muestra el camino para liberarnos de nuestros miedos y de nuestras esclavitudes, para desenmascarar nuestras hipocresías y egoísmos, para reconciliarnos con nosotros mismos y sembrar paz en nuestras familias y comunidades. Su testimonio de vida nos enseña que el celo apostólico se expresa en gestos de misericordia, de alegría y humildad.

Estoy siguiendo con lágrimas y preocupación lo que está sucediendo en Israel y Palestina:

muchas personas asesinadas, otras heridas. Rezo por esas familias que han visto transformar un día de fiesta en un día de luto y pido que los secuestrados sean liberados inmediatamente. Defenderse es un derecho de quien es atacado, pero estoy muy preocupado por el asedio total en el que viven los palestinos en Gaza, donde también ha habido muchas víctimas inocentes.

LLAMAMIENTO

El terrorismo y los extremismos no ayudan a alcanzar una solución al conflicto entre israelíes y palestinos, sino que alimentan el odio, la violencia, la venganza, y solo hacen sufrir a los unos y a los otros. Oriente Medio no necesita guerra, sino paz, una paz construida en la justicia, en el diálogo y en la valentía de la fraternidad. Dirijo un pensamiento especial a la población de Afganistán, que está sufriendo después del devastador terremoto que la ha golpeado, provocando miles de víctimas, entre las cuales muchas mujeres y niños, y de desplazados. Invito a todas las personas de buena voluntad a ayudar a este pueblo ya tan probado, contribuyendo, en espíritu de fraternidad, a aliviar los sufrimientos de la gente y a sostener la reconstrucción necesaria.

POPE FRANCIS

Dear brothers and sisters: In our catechesis on apostolic zeal, we have been reflecting on the spread of the Gospel through the witness of men and women of every time and place. Today we turn once more to Africa and to the powerful witness of Saint Josephine Bakhita. Born in Darfur in Sudan, Josephine was kidnapped as a child and sold into slavery. Despite the violence and terrible sufferings she endured, she never despaired. In the cross of Christ she discovered the source of a merciful love that affirms our innate dignity as God's children, brings true freedom and enables us to forgive and indeed love those who wrong us. The experience of God's mercy and forgiveness inspired Josephine to devote herself to Christ as a religious and to serve others humbly and selflessly in Italy, her new country. The life of Saint Josephine Bakhita reveals the power of God's grace to transform lives, to resolve conflicts and to bring about the justice, reconciliation and peace so greatly needed in our time. Let us entrust ourselves to her prayers and ask especially for the gift of peace for our brothers and sisters in war-torn Sudan and in so many other

parts of our world.

Appeals of the Holy Father

I continue to follow what is happening in Israel and Palestine with tears and apprehension: many people killed, others injured. I pray for those families who have seen a feast day transformed into a day of mourning, and I ask that the hostages be released immediately. It is the right of those who are attacked to defend themselves, but I am very concerned about the total siege under which the Palestinians are living in Gaza, where there have also been many innocent victims. Terrorism and extremism do not help reach a solution to the conflict between Israelis and Palestinians, but fuel hatred, violence, revenge, and only cause each to other suffer. The Middle East does not need war, but peace, a peace built on dialogue and the courage of fraternity.

I address a special thought to the population of Afghanistan, suffering following the devastating earthquake that struck, claiming thousands of victims, including many women and children, and displaced persons. I invite all people of good will to help this people, already sorely tried, contributing in a spirit of fraternity to alleviating the sufferings of the people and supporting the necessary reconstruction.
