



Testigos: san Francisco Javier

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

Prosiguiendo nuestro itinerario de la Catequesis con algunos modelos ejemplares de celo apostólico, hoy elegimos a san Francisco Javier, un gran misionero de los tiempos modernos.

San Francisco Javier nace de una familia noble pero empobrecida de Navarra, en el norte de España, en 1506. Va a estudiar a París —es un joven de mundo, inteligente, capaz. Allí encuentra a Ignacio de Loyola que le da ejercicios espirituales y le cambia la vida. Y deja toda su carrera mundana para hacerse misionero. Se hace jesuita, toma sus votos. Luego se convierte en sacerdote, y va a evangelizar, enviado a Oriente. El va, porque estaba lleno de celo apostólico.

Inicia así, en los tiempos modernos, el primero de un grupo de misioneros, preparados para soportar fatigas y peligros inmensos, impulsados sólo por el deseo de dar a conocer a Jesucristo y su Evangelio. Va a evangelizar a los pobres de la India, enseñando catecismo, bautizando y cuidando a los enfermos. Después, de un tiempo deja en buenas manos el trabajo que ya había iniciado y zarpa las islas más lejanas del archipiélago indonesio. ¡Qué valor tenían estos santos misioneros! Javier escribe: «Los peligros y los sufrimientos, aceptados voluntariamente y únicamente por amor y servicio de Dios nuestro Señor, son ricos tesoros de grandes consolaciones espirituales. ¡Aquí dentro de algunos años uno po-

dría perder los ojos por demasiadas lágrimas de alegría!» (20 de enero de 1548). Lloraba de alegría al ver la obra del Señor. Un día, en India, se encuentra con un japonés, que le habla de su lejano país, donde ningún misionero europeo había ido antes. Y Francisco salió lo antes posible. Tres años en Japón fueron durísimos, por el clima, las oposiciones y el desconocimiento de la lengua, pero las semillas plantadas darán grandes frutos.

El gran soñador, Javier, en Japón entiende que el país decisivo para la misión en Asia era otro: China, por eso vuelve a India, y poco después se embarca de nuevo esperando poder entrar en China. Pero su plan fracasa:

muere a las puertas de China, frente a las costas esperando en vano poder desembarcar en tierra firme. El 3 de diciembre de 1522, muere en completo abandono, sólo un chino junto a él a velarle. Así termina el viaje terreno de Francisco Javier. Tenía solamente cuarenta y seis años, había pasado su vida en la misión, con celo. Su intensa actividad estuvo siempre unida a la oración, a la unión con Dios, mística y contemplativa. Nunca abandonó la oración, porque sabía que ahí reside la fuerza. A muchos jóvenes de hoy que tienen algo de inquietud y no saben qué hacer con esa inquietud, le digo: Miren a Francisco Javier, miren el horizonte del mundo, miren a los pueblos tan necesitados, miren a tanta gente que sufre, a tanta gente que necesita a Jesús. Y vayan, tengan coraje.

Que el Señor nos dé a todos la alegría de evangelizar, la alegría de llevar adelante este mensaje tan hermoso que nos hace felices a nosotros y a todos.

The apostolic zeal; St. Francis Xavier

Dear brothers and sisters, good morning!

Continuing our itinerary of the Catecheses with some exemplary models of apostolic zeal, today, for example, we choose as an example, Saint Francis Xavier. Saint Francis Xavier is the patron of missions, like Saint Therese of the Child Jesus.

There are many, priests, lay people, women religious who go to the missions... This is incredible – to leave your own country to preach the Gospel. This is apostolic zeal.

Saint Francis Xavier was born into a noble but impoverished family in Navarre, Spain, in 1506. He went to study in Paris, he was a worldly young man, intelligent.. There, he met Ignatius of Loyola. He made the spiritual exercises and changed his life. And he left everything, his worldly career, to become a missionary. He became a Jesuit, priest, and went to evangelize, sent to the Orient. At that time, the journeys of the missionaries to the Orient meant they were sent to unknown worlds.

He will evangelize the poor of India, teaching catechism, baptizing and caring for the sick. After a while, he leaves the work he had already started in good hands and sets sail for the most distant islands of the Indonesian archipelago. What courage these missionary saints had! Javier writes: «Dangers and sufferings, accepted voluntarily and solely out of love and service to God our Lord, are rich treasures of great spiritual consolation. Here in a few years

one could lose one's eyes from too many tears of joy!» (January 20, 1548). He cried with joy when he saw the work of the Lord.

In India, he meets a Japanese man, who tells him about his distant country, where no European missionary had gone before. And Francisco left as soon as possible. Three years in Japan are very hard, due to the climate, the opposition and the lack of knowledge of the language, but here too the seeds planted will bear great fruit. The great dreamer, Javier understands that the decisive country for the mission in Asia was another: China, he returned to India, and shortly after embarked again hoping to enter China. But his plan fails: he dies at the gates of China, off the coast waiting in vain to land on the mainland. He died in complete abandonment, only a Chinese next to him to watch over him. He was only forty-six years old, had spent his life in the mission. His intense activity was always linked to prayer, to mystical and contemplative union with God. He never abandoned prayer, because he knew that strength resides there. To many young people today who have some concern and don't know what to do, I say: Look at Francisco Javier, look at the horizon of the world, look at the peoples so in need, look at so many people who suffer, at so many people who needs Jesus. And go, have courage. May the Lord give us all the joy of evangelizing, the joy of carrying forward this beautiful message that makes us and everyone happy.
